AN ACT TO REMOVE OBSOLETE LANGUAGE REGARDING THE
STAGGERING OF TERMS FOR A MEMBER OF THE ARKANSAS
STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO REMOVE OBSOLETE LANGUAGE REGARDING THE
STAGGERING OF TERMS FOR A MEMBER OF THE
ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-92-201(d), concerning the staggering of the term of the minority pharmacist member, is repealed as the language is obsolete.

~~(d) In order to appropriately stagger the terms of the pharmacist members, the term of the minority pharmacist member serving on January 1, 1999, is extended to eight (8) years. Thereafter, the term of the minority pharmacist member shall be six (6) years.~~
