AN ACT CONCERNING DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME; TO ADOPT
YEAR-ROUND STANDARD TIME AND ELIMINATE DAYLIGHT
SAVING TIME IN ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO ADOPT YEAR-ROUND STANDARD TIME AND
ELIMINATE DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME IN
ARKANSAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 1, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

1-1-104. Exemption from daylight saving time.

(a) The state exempts itself from 15 U.S.C. §260(a), as it existed on December 20, 2018, providing for the advancement of time known as "daylight saving time", during the period set by federal law for the advancement of time each calendar year.

(b) The state shall observe the standard time otherwise applicable during the period described in subsection (a) of this section.
