AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LAW CONCERNING THE EXPIRATION  
AND RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

**Subtitle**

TO CLARIFY THE LAW CONCERNING THE  
EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S  
LICENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-901(a)(1)(C), concerning the expiration and renewal of a driver's license, is amended to read as follows:

(C) An intermediate driver's license shall be issued for no more than a two-year period and shall expire upon the driver's *reaching eighteen (18) years of age and may be renewed at that time or within thirty days (30) following the expiration date of the intermediate driver's license* as a regular driver's license for eight (8) years, so long as the intermediate driver has been free of a serious accident and conviction of a serious traffic violation for at least twelve (12) months before arriving at his or her eighteenth birthday.
