AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAWS CONCERNING THE ARKANSAS
STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR FORESTERS; TO AMEND
THE QUALIFICATIONS TO BE REGISTERED AS A FORESTER;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE LAWS CONCERNING THE ARKANSAS
STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR
FORESTERS; AND TO AMEND THE
QUALIFICATIONS TO BE REGISTERED AS A
FORESTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-31-302(5), concerning the qualifications to register as a forester, is amended to read as follows:

(5) A two-year associate's degree in forestry ~~from a community college or junior college~~ and, subsequent to graduation, six (6) years' or more ~~of~~ experience in forestry work of a nature satisfactory to the board.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-31-304(c), concerning the examinations required by the Arkansas State Board of Registration for Foresters, is amended to read as follows:

(c) A candidate who fails an examination may apply for another examination ~~at the expiration of six (6) months from the date of failure of the prior examination.~~
