BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-15-202(b)(1)(F), concerning the eligibility requirements for a retired certified law enforcement officer to carry a concealed handgun, is amended to read as follows:

(F) During the most recent ~~twelve-month~~ five-year period has met, at the expense of the retired law enforcement officer, the standards of this state for training and qualification for active law enforcement officers to carry firearms;
