ANIMAL IS REQUIRED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-19-305 is amended to read as follows:

20-19-305. Vaccination for dogs, cats, and other animals required.

(a) All dogs, cats, and other animals shall be vaccinated against rabies as required by the State Board of Health.

(b) In addition to subsection (a) of this section, a person who sells a dog or cat shall provide documentation to the buyer regarding whether the dog or cat has been properly vaccinated.
