AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE PENALTIES FOR
PASSING AN AUTHORIZED VEHICLE STOPPED ON A HIGHWAY;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE PENALTIES
FOR PASSING AN AUTHORIZED VEHICLE STOPPED
ON A HIGHWAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-51-310(c)(1), concerning the passing of an authorized vehicle stopped on a highway, is amended to read as follows:

(c)(1) A person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or is found guilty of violating this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than ~~thirty-five dollars (\$35.00)~~ two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) nor more than ~~five hundred dollars (\$500)~~ one thousand dollars (\$1,000), confined in the county jail not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both fined and imprisoned.
