AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS TAX PROCEDURE ACT
CONCERNING THE HOLDING OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS; TO
AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING HOLDING ADMINISTRATIVE
HEARINGS BY ELECTRONIC MEANS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS TAX PROCEDURE ACT
CONCERNING HOLDING ADMINISTRATIVE
HEARINGS BY ELECTRONIC MEANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-18-405(f)(1), concerning hearings on proposed assessments under the Arkansas Tax Procedure Act, is amended to read as follows:

(f)(1) In addition to the hearing procedures set out in subsections (a)-(e) of this section, the director may hold administrative hearings by telephone, video conference, or other electronic means if the director determines that conducting the hearing in such a manner:

(A) Is in the best interest of the taxpayer and the department;

(B) ~~Is agreed to by both parties~~ Provides the same level of legal protection as provided in an in-person hearing or a hearing on written documents, including without limitation adequate due process;

(C) Is not ~~fiscally unsound or administratively burdensome~~ unduly expensive for the taxpayer or the department; and

(D) Adequately protects the confidentiality of the



taxpayer's information.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 1 of this act is effective on and after January 1, 2020.
