ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE OPERATION
OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON PUBLIC STREETS
AND HIGHWAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-21-106(a), concerning exceptions to the unlawful operation of all-terrain vehicles on a public street or highway, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(6) An employee of the Department of Parks and Tourism may operate a department-owned all-terrain vehicle on a public street or highway to access contiguous areas of a state park in order to perform his or duties as an employee of the department.
