# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1832

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC SCHOOL FUNDING; TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT CURRENTLY PAY A CERTAIN STARTING SALARY FOR TEACHERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT CURRENTLY PAY A CERTAIN STARTING SALARY FOR TEACHERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. Legislative intent.

The General Assembly finds that:

(1) A number of public school districts have made efforts to attain and maintain competitiveness and morale with respect to, among other things, teacher salaries; and

(2) It is necessary to financially supplement such public school districts in light of the efforts the public school districts have taken to sufficiently pay teachers despite financial conditions.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 24, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-17-2408. Additional funding.

(a) During the 2019-2020 school year, the following public school districts shall receive additional funding in the amounts as follows to



supplement salaries of the teachers in the public school districts:
