## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING REDUCED TUITION TO A TWO-YEAR OR FOUR-YEAR STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN ARKANSAS; TO AWARD TO A CHILD WHOSE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN IS A FULL-TIME LICENSED TEACHER IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT IN ARKANSAS A DISCOUNTED TUITION RATE TO A TWO-YEAR OR FOUR-YEAR STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AWARD TO A CHILD WHOSE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN IS A LICENSED TEACHER IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT IN ARKANSAS A DISCOUNTED TUITION RATE TO A STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN ARKANSAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 80, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-80-109. Children of public school teachers – Reduced tuition.

A child in this state who is under twenty-four (24) years of age whose parent or legal guardian is employed as a full-time licensed teacher in a public school district in this state shall receive a discount of ten percent (10%) on tuition to a two-year or four-year state-supported institution of



higher education in this state.
