HOUSE RESOLUTION

TO AMEND THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY; TO RENAME THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE AND ITS STANDING SUBCOMMITTEES; AND TO REASSIGN THE MATTERS THAT ARE ASSIGNED TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE AND ITS SUBCOMMITTEES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 92ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 53.(a) of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly is amended to read as follows:

53.(a) HOUSE STANDING COMMITTEES

Class "A" Committees

Education

Judiciary

Public Health, Welfare and Labor

~~Public Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy, and Environment~~

Revenue and Taxation

Class "B" Committees

Aging, Children and Youth, Legislative and Military Affairs

Agriculture, Forestry and Economic Development



City, County and Local Affairs
Insurance and Commerce
State Agencies and Governmental Affairs

SECTION 2. Section 64.(3) of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly is amended to read as follows:

64.(3) Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor – matters pertaining to public health, mental health, ~~mental retardation~~ developmental disabilities, public welfare, human relations and resources, ~~environmental affairs, water and air pollution,~~ labor and labor relations, contractors and contracting, similar legislation, and resolutions germane to the subject matter of the committee;

SECTION 3. Section 64.(4) of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly is amended to read as follows:

64.(4) Committee on ~~Public Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy, and Environment~~ – matters pertaining to roads and highways, city streets, county roads, road vehicles, highway safety, airports and air transportation, common and contract carriers, mass transit, environmental affairs, wastewater, water and air pollution, energy, oil and gas, similar legislation, and resolutions germane to the subject matter of the committee;

SECTION 4. Section 64.(7) of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly is amended to read as follows:

64.(7) Committee on Agriculture, Forestry and Economic Development – matters pertaining to agriculture, livestock, forestry, industrial development, ~~natural resources, oil and gas,~~ levees and drainage, rivers and harbors, similar legislation and resolutions germane to the subject matter of the committee;

SECTION 5. Section 64.(10)(a)(2) of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly is amended to read as follows:

64.(10)(a)(2) For the House standing committee on Agriculture, Forestry and Economic Development, the following permanent subcommittees are created:

- (1) *Agriculture, Forestry and Natural Resources*
- (2) Small Business and Economic Development
- (3) Parks and Tourism

SECTION 6. Section 64.(10)(a)(7) of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly is amended to read as follows:

64.(10)(a)(7) For the House standing committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor, the following permanent subcommittees are created:

- (1) Human Services
- (2) Health Services
- (3) Labor ~~and Environment~~

SECTION 7. Section 64.(10)(a)(8) of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly is amended to read as follows:

64.(10)(a)(8) For the House standing committee on ~~Public Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy, and Environment~~, the following permanent subcommittees are created:

- (1) ~~Motor Vehicle and Highways~~ Transportation Infrastructure
- (2) ~~Public Transportation and Rail~~ Environmental Infrastructure
- (3) ~~Waterways and Aeronautics~~ Energy and Technology Infrastructure

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution is effective upon and after sine die adjournment of the 2019 regular legislative session.
