## HOUSE RESOLUTION

TO AMEND THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND TO REMOVE THE TIME LIMIT BEFORE A BILL MAY BE BROUGHT UP FOR A THIRD READING IN THE HOUSE CHAMBER.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

*SECTION 1. Section 41 of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly, concerning the third reading of a bill, is amended to read as follows:*

*41.(a) A bill shall not be called for a third reading and final passage until a photocopied, printed copy, or electronic copy of same shall have been placed on every representative's desk for twenty-four (24) hours.*

*The twenty-four (24) hour period begins when a bill is initially introduced and read across the desk. ~~No regular bill or resolution may be brought up for a third reading and final passage on the Floor of the House until it has been on the calendar of the House for at least two (2) days.~~*

*41.(b) A bill shall not be placed on a committee agenda until the second calendar day following the initial filing of the bill.*
