WHEREAS, Southeast Arkansas College, originally named Arkansas Vocational-Technical School as created by Act 328 of 1957, began offering classes on September 21, 1959; and

WHEREAS, Southeast Arkansas College was created by Act 1244 of the 78th General Assembly of the State of Arkansas, which was signed into law by then-Governor Bill Clinton on April 17, 1991; and

WHEREAS, the college, known as SEARK College, was one of the first vocational-technical schools in Arkansas to meet the needs of industry, provide jobs, and raise the standard of living for Arkansas citizens; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the college is to provide comprehensive community college education and services, with an emphasis on technical education and workforce development for the citizens of Jefferson, Cleveland, Desha, Drew, Grant, and Lincoln counties; and

WHEREAS, the educational programs and services include technical career education, workforce development, university transfer education, general



education, adult education, continuing education, and community services,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the House of Representatives commend and celebrate Southeast Arkansas College for 60 years of service to the citizens of the State of Arkansas.
