## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A  
SUPPORT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE TO  
PERSONS WITH CERTAIN CRIMINAL HISTORIES; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROHIBIT THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A  
SUPPORT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT SPECIAL  
LICENSE PLATE TO PERSONS WITH CERTAIN  
CRIMINAL HISTORIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-24-1316(c), concerning the issuance of a special license plate for support of law enforcement, is amended to read as follows:

(c)(1) Any ~~Except as provided in subdivision (c)(2) of this section,~~ any motor vehicle owner may apply for and annually renew a special license plate created by this section.

(2) The department may not issue or renew a special license plate under this section to a person required to register as a sex offender under the Sex Offender Registration Act of 1997, § 12-12-901 et seq.

SECTION 2. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. A person required to register as a sex offender under the Sex Offender Registration Act of 1997, § 12-12-901 et seq., who, before the effective date of this act, has been issued a special license plate under this section, is neither required to



return the special license plate to the department nor required to apply for the issuance of a standard Arkansas license plate to replace the special license plate until the annual renewal date of the special license plate.
