AN ACT TO PROTECT TRADITIONAL HUNTING METHODS; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROTECT TRADITIONAL HUNTING METHODS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 43, Subchapter 2, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

15-43-241. Traditional hunting methods – Hunting with dogs.

(a) The right to hunt guaranteed to Arkansas citizens by Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 88, includes the right of citizens of Arkansas to employ traditional hunting methods.

(b) Traditional hunting methods include without limitation:

- (1) Bow hunting;
- (2) Gun hunting;
- (3) Hunting with the assistance of a dog;
- (4) Spear hunting;
- (5) Stalk hunting; and
- (6) Trapping.
