OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE RABIES CONTROL ACT REGARDING
VACCINATIONS AGAINST RABIES FOR ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-19-305 is amended to read as follows:

20-19-305. Vaccination for dogs, cats, and other animals required.

(a) All dogs, cats, and other animals shall be vaccinated against rabies as required by the State Board of Health.

(b) Laboratory testing or other testing that is unrelated to rabies shall not be required before the administration of the vaccine against rabies.
