SENATE BILL 295

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROMOTE THE COLLECTION OF LABOR MARKET DATA; TO REQUIRE EMPLOYERS TO PARTICIPATE IN SURVEYS CONDUCTED BY THE BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROMOTE THE COLLECTION OF LABOR MARKET DATA; AND TO REQUIRE EMPLOYERS TO PARTICIPATE IN SURVEYS CONDUCTED BY THE BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 11, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

11-10-112. Labor market data – Collection of data.

(a) Except as provided under subsection (b) of this section, under this chapter an employer that employs an individual in this state shall participate in any labor market information survey that is conducted by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor by completing without limitation:

(1) A Multiple Worksite Report;

(2) An Industry Verification Form; and

(3) An Occupational Employment Statistics survey.

(b) This section applies to an employer with twenty-five (25) or more



employees.

(c) The Department of Workforce Services shall use labor market data to enable the department to serve an employer.
