## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION  
REQUIREMENTS OF A SEX OFFENDER; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE  
REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS OF A SEX  
OFFENDER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-906(a)(1)(A), concerning the duty of a sex offender to register or verify registration, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(iii) A sex offender is not required to register as a sex offender under this subchapter if the:

(a) Victim was under eighteen (18) years of age and the sex offender was no more than three (3) years older than the victim at the time of the sex offense;

(b) Court determines that there was no evidence of force, compulsion, threat, or intimidation in the commission of the sex offense; and

(c) Court does not otherwise order registration under § 12-12-903(B)(i).
