SENATE BILL 353

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT A STATEMENT OF LEGISLATIVE INTENT BE INCLUDED IN A BILL THAT AUTHORIZES PROMULGATION OF STATE AGENCY RULES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REQUIRE THAT A STATEMENT OF LEGISLATIVE INTENT BE INCLUDED IN A BILL THAT AUTHORIZES PROMULGATION OF STATE AGENCY RULES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-309, concerning the review and approval of state agency rules, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(j)(1) In order to provide guidance to the Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee when conducting their review of rules under this section, a bill that authorizes or requires a state agency to promulgate rules shall contain a legislative intent section.

(2) The legislative intent section shall state the intent of the legislature regarding the scope and the purpose of the rules to be promulgated.
