AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING PENALTIES RELATED TO ADMINISTRATIVE INSPECTION WARRANTS EXECUTED BY THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING PENALTIES RELATED TO ADMINISTRATIVE INSPECTION WARRANTS EXECUTED BY THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-1-107(f), concerning administrative inspection warrants executed by the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality, is amended to read as follows:

(f) Penalties. Any ~~willful and unjustified~~ knowing refusal of right of entry and inspection to department personnel as set out in this section ~~shall constitute a misdemeanor~~ is a violation subject to a fine of up to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or civil penalties up to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).
