## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE ADMINISTRATION  
OF PUBLIC OATHS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE  
ADMINISTRATION OF PUBLIC OATHS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-2-105(a)(3), concerning oaths of office for public officials, is amended to read as follows:

(3) All other officers, both civil and military, shall take their oaths before:

(A) The Secretary of State or his or her official designee;

(B) A justice or judge of the:

(i) Supreme Court;

(ii) Court of Appeals;

(iii) Circuit court;

(iv) District court; or

(v) County court;

(C) The clerk of the county court;

(D) The clerk of the circuit court; ~~or~~

(E) A justice of the peace;

(F) A clerk of a city of the first class; or

(G) A recorder of a city of the second class or incorporated town.
