WHEREAS, there are currently 88 embassies in the country of Israel, with all but 2 located in the city of Tel Aviv; and

WHEREAS, the United States Embassy in Israel relocated from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem in 2018; and

WHEREAS, the United States has encouraged other countries around the world to follow the lead of our country and do the same; and

WHEREAS, after the United States relocated, Guatemala made the decision to move the Guatemalan Embassy in Israel to Jerusalem,

NOW THEREFORE,
