WHEREAS, Shawn McKeough Jr., a senior airman in the United States Air Force, was killed at the age of 23 on March 15, 2019, while attempting to stop an armed robbery in North Little Rock, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, Mr. McKeough was a man of integrity and duty, placing his own life at risk to protect those around him; and

WHEREAS, Mr. McKeough served his country in Germany, South Korea, Kuwait, and several conflict areas, twice receiving the Air Force Achievement Medal; and

WHEREAS, Mr. McKeough, a native of Westbrook, Maine, was an aerial delivery operations specialist for the 19th Logistic Readiness Squadron, preparing aerial delivery loads and aircrew training bundles for the C-130s of the 19th Airlift Wing, part of Air Mobility Command; and

WHEREAS, Mr. McKeough is survived by his girlfriend, Sarah Terrano, family members, and friends who remember him for the hero he was,
