WHEREAS, in 2019, Representative Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez of the United States House of Representatives and Senator Ed Markey of the United States Senate filed a pair of resolutions called the "Green New Deal"; and

WHEREAS, the Green New Deal resolutions propose a massive government spending program; and

WHEREAS, the Green New Deal resolutions propose a government-mandated green economy which would create substantial financial burden on the citizens of Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, in a summary of a recent study of the Green New Deal resolutions, the estimated costs range from \$51 trillion to \$93 trillion over 10 years, or around \$600,000 per household; and

WHEREAS, the United States Senate recently voted down one of the resolutions,
