SENATE RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND SECTIONS 14.(B)(2) AND 14.(B)(3) OF THE
JOINT RULES OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY
TO AUTHORIZE THE INTRODUCTION OF A BILL CREATING THE
TRANSFORMATION AND EFFICIENCIES ACT OF 2019 ON A DATE
AFTER THE FIFTEENTH CALENDAR DAY OF THE 2019
LEGISLATIVE SESSION.

Subtitle

TO SUSPEND SECTIONS 14.(B)(2) AND
14.(B)(3) OF THE JOINT RULES OF THE
SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

WHEREAS, section 14.(B)(2) of the Joint Rules of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly states that "Any proposed legislation affecting any publicly supported retirement system or pension plan to be considered by the General Assembly at a regular session shall be introduced in the General Assembly during the first fifteen (15) calendar days of a regular session.";

WHEREAS, Section 14.(B)(3) of the Joint Rules of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly states that "No such bill shall be introduced after the fifteenth (15th) day of a regular session unless its introduction is first approved by a three-fourths (3/4)



vote of the full membership of each house of the General Assembly."; and

WHEREAS, the bill that will create the Transformation and Efficiencies Act of 2019 may affect publicly supported retirement systems or pension plans,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT sections 14.(B)(2) and 14.(B)(3) of the Joint Rules of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly are hereby suspended in order to allow Senator Bart Hester and Representative Andy Davis to introduce a bill creating the Transformation and Efficiencies Act of 2019 on a date after the fifteenth calendar day of the 2019 Regular Session.
