18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-3-102(h), concerning licensing
21 restrictions based on criminal records, is amended to read as follows:

22 (h) This section does not apply to licensure or certification:

23 (1) Of professions not governed by this title;

24 (2) Of polygraph examiners and voice stress analysis examiners
25 under § 17-39-101 et seq.; ~~or~~

26 (3) Of private investigators and private security agencies under
27 the Private Security Agency, Private Investigator, and School Security
28 Licensing and Credentialing Act, § 17-40-101 et seq.; or

29 (4) Of barbers under the Arkansas Barber Law, § 17-20-101 et
