AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE DIRECTOR OF THE ASSESSMENT COORDINATION DIVISION; TO ALLOW THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO APPOINT THE DIRECTOR OF THE ASSESSMENT COORDINATION DIVISION AND TO STATE THAT THE APPOINTEE MEETS THE LEGAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE POSITION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO ALLOW THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO APPOINT THE DIRECTOR OF THE ASSESSMENT COORDINATION DIVISION AND TO STATE THAT THE APPOINTEE MEETS THE LEGAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE POSITION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-28-101(b), concerning the creation of the Assessment Coordination Division and the appointment of the Director of the Assessment Coordination Division and other personnel, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) The executive head of the Assessment Coordination Division ~~shall be~~ is the Director of the Assessment Coordination Division.

(2) The director shall be appointed by the Governor, ~~subject to confirmation by the Senate, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.~~



~~(3) The director shall report to the Secretary of the Department of Finance and Administration and shall report to the secretary.~~

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 25-28-107 is amended to read as follows:

25-28-107. Requirements of Director of the Assessment Coordination Division.

(a) The Director of the Assessment Coordination Division shall meet the qualifications required for certification or licensure as a Level 4 Appraiser in Arkansas, provided that the formal course work was or is satisfactorily completed in another state.

(b) At the time of appointing the director, the ~~Governor~~ Secretary of the Department of Finance and Administration shall include in the appointment document a statement that the appointee meets the qualifications prescribed by law.
