## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ALLOW ONLY ON-PREMISES SALES OF ALCOHOLIC  
BEVERAGES ON CHRISTMAS DAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO ALLOW ONLY ON-PREMISES SALES OF  
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON CHRISTMAS DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-3-211 is amended to read as follows:

3-3-211. ~~Sales~~ Off-premises sales on Christmas Day prohibited.

(a) It ~~shall be~~ is unlawful to sell intoxicating alcoholic liquors for off-premises consumption on Christmas Day.

(b) Any person who ~~shall sell~~ sells intoxicating alcoholic liquors for off-premises consumption on Christmas Day ~~shall be~~ is guilty of a Class B misdemeanor.
