### **For An Act To Be Entitled**

AN ACT TO AMEND THE PROHIBITIONS ON ADVERTISING AND  
USE OF CERTAIN SYMBOLS REGARDING MEDICAL MARIJUANA;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### **Subtitle**

TO AMEND THE PROHIBITIONS ON ADVERTISING  
AND USE OF CERTAIN SYMBOLS REGARDING  
MEDICAL MARIJUANA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-56-305(b), concerning prohibitions on advertising and use of certain symbols regarding medical marijuana, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(7) A cultivation facility or dispensary, or both, shall not use any of the following images within an advertisement, including without limitation:

(A) A cross of any color;

(B) A caduceus; or

(C) Any other symbol that is commonly associated with the practice of medicine or the practice of pharmacy.
