AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC SCHOOL FUNDING; TO AMEND THE
ADDITIONAL FUNDING USED FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND
ADMINISTRATION OF PROFESSIONAL LEARNING COMMUNITIES;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE ADDITIONAL FUNDING USED FOR
THE DEVELOPMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF
PROFESSIONAL LEARNING COMMUNITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2305(b)(5)(D)(i), concerning funding amounts for professional learning communities, is amended to read as follows:

(D)(i) For the ~~2019-2020 and 2020-2021~~ 2021-2022 school year, additional funding up to fourteen million five hundred thousand dollars (\$14,500,000), and for the 2022-2023 school years year, additional funding up to twelve million five hundred thousand dollars (\$12,500,000) sixteen million five hundred thousand dollars (\$16,500,000), provided for professional development above the amount in subdivisions (b)(5)(A) and (B) of this section shall be used by the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education for the development and administration of professional learning communities for the benefit of public school districts.
