AN ACT CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENTS THAT NEED TO BE MET BEFORE A SEX OFFENDER CAN HAVE HIS OR HER OBLIGATION TO REGISTER TERMINATED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENTS THAT NEED TO BE MET BEFORE A SEX OFFENDER CAN HAVE HIS OR HER OBLIGATION TO REGISTER TERMINATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-919(b)(1)(A)(i)(a), concerning an application for an order terminating the obligation to register as a sex offender, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1)(A)(i)(a) Any other sex offender required to register under this subchapter may apply in the jurisdiction in which he or she was convicted for an order terminating the obligation to register to the sentencing court fifteen (15) years after the date the sex offender first registered in Arkansas.
