AN ACT TO EXEMPT BARBERS FROM LICENSING RESTRICTIONS
BASED ON CRIMINAL RECORDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO EXEMPT BARBERS FROM LICENSING
RESTRICTIONS BASED ON CRIMINAL RECORDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-3-102(h), concerning licensing restrictions based on criminal records, is amended to read as follows:

(h) This section does not apply to licensure or certification:

(1) Of professions not governed by this title;

(2) Of polygraph examiners and voice stress analysis examiners

under § 17-39-101 et seq.; ~~or~~

(3) Of private investigators and private security agencies under the Private Security Agency, Private Investigator, and School Security Licensing and Credentialing Act, § 17-40-101 et seq.; or

(4) Of barbers under the Arkansas Barber Law, § 17-20-101 et seq.
