AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CERTAIN CLASSES OF
COUNTY ROADS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CERTAIN
CLASSES OF COUNTY ROADS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-299-101 is amended to read as follows:
14-299-101. Classification of roads.

(a) All public roads and highways running most centrally through the county and most used by the public shall be designated by the county court as first-class roads and all other public roads and highways as second-class roads.

(b) A county court shall not close public access to a class five (5) collector or heavier-use road that is within one-fourth (1/4) of a mile from an interchange with a United States highway.
