AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CAMPAIGN SIGNS AND MATERIALS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CAMPAIGN SIGNS AND MATERIALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-6-228(c), concerning campaign signs and materials, is amended to read as follows:

(c)(1)(A) Campaign signs, campaign literature, and other printed campaign materials ~~under this section~~ shall clearly contain the words "Paid for by" followed by the name of the candidate, committee, or person who paid for the campaign sign, campaign literature, or other printed campaign materials.

(B) The candidate printing the campaign sign, campaign literature, or other printed campaign materials shall be responsible for including the language required by subdivision (c)(1)(A) of this section.

(2) Subdivision (c)(1)(A) of this section applies only to campaign signs, campaign literature, and other printed campaign materials created by or sponsored by a political candidate, the campaign of a political candidate, a political action committee, or an independent expenditure committee.
