For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING LOCAL OPTION ELECTIONS IN DEFUNCT VOTING DISTRICTS THAT RESULTED FROM INITIATED MEASURE 1 OF 1942; TO AUTHORIZE ELECTIONS IN DEFUNCT VOTING DISTRICTS FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

REGARDING LOCAL OPTION ELECTIONS IN DEFUNCT VOTING DISTRICTS THAT RESULTED FROM INITIATED MEASURE 1 OF 1942; AND TO AUTHORIZE ELECTIONS FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-8-602(a)(2), concerning the sale of alcoholic beverages in a defunct voting district, is amended to read as follows:

(2) The sale of alcoholic beverages under this section shall be limited to beer, malt beverages, vinous beverages, and spirituous liquor for on-premises or off-premises consumption within the corporate limits of a city of the first class or a city of the second class.
