AN ACT TO CREATE ARKANSAS DAY; TO CHANGE CONFEDERATE
FLAG DAY TO ARKANSAS DAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO CREATE ARKANSAS DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 1-5-107 is amended to read as follows:

1-5-107. ~~Confederate Flag~~ Arkansas Day.

(a) The Saturday immediately preceding Easter Sunday of each year is designated as "~~Confederate Flag~~ Arkansas Day" in this state.

(b) Arkansas Day shall be a day to reflect on the rich history, national treasures, diverse cultures, unmatched hospitality, shared spirit, and human resilience that make the people of this state proud to be Arkansans.
