## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING

### Subtitle

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION  
CONCERNING RULES OF PLEADING, PRACTICE,  
PROCEDURE, AND EVIDENCE IN ALL COURTS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this joint resolution is to propose an amendment to the Arkansas Constitution concerning rules of pleading, practice, procedure, and evidence in all courts.
