WHEREAS, for the first time since 1995, the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville men's Arkansas Razorbacks basketball team qualified for the Elite Eight in the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament, held this year in Indianapolis, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, in the second round of the tournament on Sunday, March 21, 2021, the No. 3 seed Arkansas Razorbacks bested the No. 6 seed Texas Tech Red Raiders by two (2) points for a final score of 68-66 and earned a place in the Sweet Sixteen; and

WHEREAS, the Sweet Sixteen was held on Saturday, March 27, and pitted



the Arkansas Razorbacks against the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles, a team the Arkansas Razorbacks beat by two (2) points for a final score of 72-70; and

WHEREAS, the win qualified the team for the Elite Eight and a matchup on Monday, March 29, with the No. 1 seed and eventual national champion, the Baylor Bears, and the Arkansas Razorbacks played a hard-fought and excellent game, putting Baylor through their toughest competition in the entire tournament; and

WHEREAS, Coach Eric Musselman and staff have done an outstanding job bringing together a team primarily composed of newcomers and persevering through perhaps the most challenging year in college basketball history; and

WHEREAS, the team has reignited the fan base and instilled a sense of pride throughout Arkansas by their tremendous effort and success in securing a spot in the Elite Eight twenty-six (26) years after the team's last appearance; and
