### **For An Act To Be Entitled**

AN ACT TO CREATE THE WORKING TAXPAYER RELIEF ACT; TO ALLOW AN INCOME TAX CREDIT BASED ON AN INDIVIDUAL'S INCOME; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### **Subtitle**

TO CREATE THE WORKING TAXPAYER RELIEF ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Working Taxpayer Relief Act".

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 26, Chapter 51, Subchapter 5, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

26-51-515. Working Taxpayer Relief Credit.

(a) There is established the "Working Taxpayer Relief Credit", which is allowed against the income tax imposed by this chapter in an amount equal to three percent (3%) of the credit allowed to the taxpayer under 26 U.S.C. § 32, as it existed on January 1, 2021.

(b) If the amount of the income tax credit allowed under this section exceeds the taxpayer's income tax liability, the excess shall be refunded to the taxpayer.

(c) The Department of Finance and Administration shall notify taxpayers annually of their potential eligibility for the income tax credit allowed under this section.



SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2021.
