TO REPEAL OBSOLETE LANGUAGE CONCERNING
THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE ARKANSAS HOME
INSPECTOR REGISTRATION BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-52-306(15), concerning the powers and duties of the Arkansas Home Inspector Registration Board, is repealed.

~~(15)(A) Assume the Secretary of the Department of Labor and Licensing's responsibilities for home inspector registration by development of or contracting for a support organization to perform the administrative duties required by the board if the fund totals at least fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).~~

~~(B) If the fund totals at least fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) and the board votes to transfer the responsibilities of the Secretary of the Department of Labor and Licensing to the board, then the board shall give written notice to the Secretary of the Department of Labor and Licensing ninety (90) calendar days before the transfer; and~~

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-52-312(d)(2), concerning the Arkansas Home Inspectors Registration Fund, is repealed.

~~(2) The secretary shall retain twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for~~



~~processing registration applications and renewals until this process is transferred to the Arkansas Home Inspector Registration Board.~~
