AN ACT CONCERNING REPRESENTATION OF A CORPORATE OR
BUSINESS ENTITY IN A CLAIM OR ACTION FILED WITH THE
ARKANSAS STATE CLAIMS COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

CONCERNING REPRESENTATION OF A CORPORATE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-10-222 is amended to read as follows:

19-10-222. Corporate or business entity to be represented by attorney.

(a) A Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a
corporate or business entity created under the laws of this state or another
state shall be represented at all times in a claim or action under this
subchapter by an attorney licensed to practice law in this state.

(b) Representation by an attorney licensed to practice law in this
state is not required under this section if:

(1) The amount of money at issue is less than two thousand
dollars (\$2,000); or

(2) The claim is:

(A) An uncontested claim for the reissuance of a warrant;

or



(B) For the refund of a liquor license permit application
fee.
