AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 4 OF
THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING BUSINESS AND COMMERCIAL
LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 4
OF THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING BUSINESS
AND COMMERCIAL LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 4-96-306(4), concerning affirmative defenses to a claim under the Arkansas New Farm Machinery Quality Assurance Act, is amended to correct an error of syntax to read as follows:

(4) ~~If there~~ There are ~~any~~ other defenses allowed by law that may be raised against the claim.

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. CONSTRUCTION AND LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

It is the intent of the General Assembly that:

(1) The enactment and adoption of this act shall not expressly or impliedly repeal an act passed during the regular session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly;

(2) To the extent that a conflict exists between an act of the regular session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly and this act:

(A) The act of the regular session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly shall be treated as a subsequent act passed by the General



Assembly for the purposes of:

(i) Giving the act of the regular session of the
Ninety-Third General Assembly its full force and effect; and

(ii) Amending or repealing the appropriate parts of
the Arkansas Code of 1987; and

(B) Section 1-2-107 shall not apply; and

(3) This act shall make only technical, not substantive, changes
to the Arkansas Code of 1987.
