AN ACT CONCERNING THE ARKANSAS ACADEMIC CHALLENGE
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - PART 2; TO AMEND THE LAW WITH
RESPECT TO BASIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR AWARDS
GRANTED UNDER THE ARKANSAS ACADEMIC CHALLENGE
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - PART 2; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

*TO AMEND THE LAW WITH RESPECT TO BASIC
ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR AWARDS
GRANTED UNDER THE ARKANSAS ACADEMIC
CHALLENGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - PART 2.*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-85-206, concerning basic eligibility requirements for a student applying for an Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(12) The applicant has achieved a high school grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

SECTION 2. *EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1, 2022.*
