AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING EARLY VOTING;

OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING EARLY  
VOTING; AND TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW  
CONCERNING ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-418(a)(1)(A), concerning early voting, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (a)(1)(B) of this section, early voting shall be available to any qualified elector who applies to the county clerk's designated early voting location, beginning fifteen (15) days before a preferential primary or general election between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Saturday and ending at ~~5:00 p.m.~~ 4:00 p.m. on the ~~Monday~~ Saturday before the election.
