For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ELECTIONEERING; TO
AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING PENALTIES FOR MISDEMEANOR
OFFENSES RELATED TO VOTING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING
ELECTIONEERING; AND TO AMEND THE LAW
CONCERNING PENALTIES FOR MISDEMEANOR
OFFENSES RELATED TO VOTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-1-103(a), concerning definitions, penalties, and miscellaneous misdemeanor offenses relating to elections, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(23) A person shall not enter or remain in an area within one hundred feet (100') of the primary exterior entrance to a building where voting is taking place except for a person entering or leaving a building where voting is taking place for lawful purposes.
