AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING THE
ENFORCEMENT OF ELECTION LAWS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING THE
ENFORCEMENT OF ELECTION LAWS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-1-109 is amended to read as follows:
7-1-109. Enforcement of election laws.

Following a written complaint concerning any election law violation or irregularity to the county board of election commissioners, the written complaint shall be sent by the county board of election commissioners to the ~~appropriate county clerk and appropriate prosecuting attorney~~ State Board of Election Commissioners for evaluation.
