AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE PAYMENT OF WAGES; TO ESTABLISH PARAMETERS REGARDING THE RECOUPMENT OF OVERPAYMENTS BY EMPLOYERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE PAYMENT OF WAGES; AND TO ESTABLISH PARAMETERS REGARDING THE RECOUPMENT OF OVERPAYMENTS BY EMPLOYERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 11, Chapter 4, Subchapter 4, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

11-4-406. Recoupment of overpayment of wages.

(a) In order to recoup an overpayment of wages paid to an employee, an employer shall:

(1) Provide written notice to an employee at least twenty-one (21) days in advance before first deducting from the employee's wages; and

(2) Deduct no more than twenty percent (20%) of the employee's gross wages per pay period to recoup the overpayment.

(b) The advance written notice required under subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall specify the:

(1) Amount of overpayment to be recouped;

(2) Method used to calculate the overpayment; and



(3) Cause of the overpayment.

(c) An employer that violates this section shall:

(1) Return to the employee any deductions made from the employee's paychecks; and

(2) Pay the employee an additional amount equal to the improper deductions taken from the employee's wages as liquidated damages.

(d) Subsections (a)-(c) of this section do not apply to the recoupment of an overpayment of wages by an employer when the overpayment of wages:

(1) Is discovered after only one (1) pay period; or

(2) Has been paid to an employee who is employed in a grant-funded position.
