For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW TO ALLOW FOR CONSISTENCY IN OPERATIONS OF A VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT IN AN INCORPORATED TOWN OR A CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW TO ALLOW FOR CONSISTENCY IN OPERATIONS OF A VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT IN AN INCORPORATED TOWN OR A CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-20-108(e), concerning dues for volunteer fire departments, is amended to *add an additional subdivision* to read as follows:

(3) If an attested petition is filed with the city or town recorder and signed by a majority of registered voters in the volunteer fire department district voting in the immediately preceding general election, then the governing body of the incorporated town or city of the second class by ordinance shall dispense with a special election on the levy of volunteer fire department dues.
