## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING MAYORS AS PERSONS  
WHO MAY SOLEMNIZE MARRIAGES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING MAYORS AS  
PERSONS WHO MAY SOLEMNIZE MARRIAGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 9-11-213(a)(6), concerning persons who may solemnize marriages, is amended to read as follows:

(6) The former mayor of any city of the first or second class who served at least five (5) years as mayor or the current mayor of any city or town;
